She took great pride in her work and enjoyed helping thousands of couples on their special wedding day. Christine was a devout Christian who devoted much of her time and God-given talents to her church, Lookout Avenue Baptist Church. She was a charter member and served in the choir,

WMU, GA's, Lottie Moon Mission, and VBS. She was the Sunday School Director for many, many years. Even in sickness, she was a faithful steward. She was steadfast in her faith. Christine knew the power of prayer. She led many beautiful, heartfelt prayers throughout her lifetime. She loved to take cruises and travel abroad to places such as England and France. She also loved her trips to the Biltmore House. In her later years, she thoroughly enjoyed watching the Hallmark Channel, eating potato chips with Hersey's chocolate bars, and solving word finds. Oftentimes, she would say "Lord, you can take this old body, but please don't take my mind." The Lord blessed her with a resilient mind and an impeccable memory. 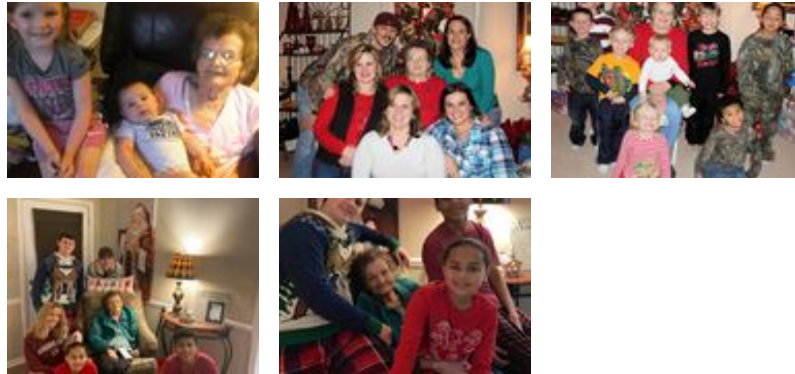
