“ I woke up at 4,:30 am this morning after having a very real dream about Maybelle. I was in a funeral home asking for a large Bible to do her funeral with because I need one.i woke up..sat up in bed..got my phone..looked her up..she passed away in 2021...with no family..I'm in tears..uncontrollable tears...was this a vision? Yes I believe it was...I'm asking for a Bible to preach her funeral..someone gave me a large white one as I was standing at the podium..maybelle was a Gid fearing woman..she was a loving and devoted wife to her husband, Talmadge McCune who preceeded her in death after a brief illness from cancer. He is buried out at Sugarhill first Baptist church in sugarhill, GA he was born in 1933 and died in 1993. I moved in with them and helped look after them both until he git sick and passed from his cancer. I had promised him I would take care of his wife maybelle should he pass on. I moved her into my rented home with me when she started having problems..I found out her next of kin was in gadsden Alabama and I looked up the mileage and gassed up my car and drove her there to meet a cousin in overalls who met us and I left maybelle with her family...she and her husband used to live next door to my late mother, Joann Smith cofer who died after pulling in front of a train. We live right next to the railroad tracks. I was allowed to go visit them everyday and I did some work digging up an old boxwood bush next to the porch of their rental house..I worked hard. He paid me with an old Swiss pocket watch he had that became one of my treasures..it was all he had. He had no money you see, he wS crippled with cerebral palsy and in a wheelchair. He needed help and he got that from his devoted wife Maybelle..she washed him, changed him, but when they got their checks on the first of the month he took her out to eat at captain ds and Kentucky fried chicken he paid his bills. Maybelle always wire a dress below the knees and wore a slip on tennis shoe the old kind I don't think you can find anymore...navy blue boat shoe kind of...we were separated after my mom got killed by that train..it really drew up a lot of people to pray for me cause I was in the car with her along with my baby brother and I was put into a coma from my massive head injury...my baby brother witnessed it all from the

backseat surrounded by our junky stuffed animals. I got to meet up with them later on after becoming an adult..I was riding down the road they lived on and saw an old trunk discarded by the side of the road for garbage pickup..it was his mother's family Bible loaded with information on the McCune family. I kept it and was able to pass it on to one of his family members around the west Burford area..I don't know the meaning of my dream but I wish to hear from the pastor that did her funeral.
