Mr. Bayne was born June 15, 1930 in Attalla, AL. After graduating from Etowah High School, he was drafted into the US Army where he served a 2 year term in Germany during the Korean War. During this time he learned that he loved to cook. He served as a manager at Catfish Cabin, and his family and friends enjoyed seeing him there and loved the great catfish and hushpuppies that he would serve. Coy's life revolved around his mom, sister and nieces. His niece, Edith, fondly remembers at all the holiday gatherings she would run to the door every few minutes to check for her uncle's arrival. The holiday celebration could not begin until he arrived.

Coy loved to go fishing. There was no place he would have rather been at than a body of water fishing until his coolers were filled with fish. When the weather became too cold to fish, he could be found in front of his TV watching football.

In his latter years as he became ill and was hospitalized, his humor always kept everyone laughing. Whether it was a doctor, nurse, technician, EMT or

any other hospital staff member, he always spoke to them and told them “thank you.” He always had a positive attitude about any situation he was in and always showed appreciation and gratitude to anyone who helped take care of him.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Thomas I. Bayne and Lillian Pearl Nelson; sister, Betty Bayne Hulsey; and niece, Kathy Hulsey Seeling.

Coy is survived by his niece, Edith Dail (Tom); great-nieces, Andrea Clark and Coleen Guillory; and great-nephews, Brian Dail and Brandon Dail.
