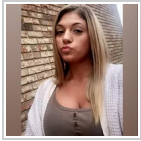
She loved being around family and friends, she also loved writing short stories and children's books.

According to Jane's wishes, a celebration of life will be held with family and close loved ones at a later date.

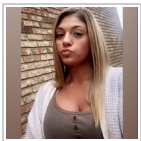
